Bonnie explained the purpose of the plots, challenges in getting started and progress so far. Two plots of 3 ha will target Silver Banksia and Sweet Bursaria. 2.50 pm	13	Climate ready revegetation: through the lens of Central Victoria's climate projections  Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning	Geoff Caine (Program Manager Community and Partnerships – Loddon Mallee region) with Dona Cayetana	Geoff presented climate projections for our region indicating weather conditions outside the historical range by 2030s, increasing in 2050s and 2090s. By 2030s we can expect higher summer temperatures, less winter rainfall (more in November and autumn), more heatwaves and droughts, and possibly more flooding. This may affect plant distribution, ecosystem composition, structure and function, and human health and safety. Geoff then answered questions from the audience.
